Remember to fill in your child's reading record each time they have been listened to. Support your child to develop their understanding of texts by summarising what they have read, asking questions, as well as making predictions about what is going to happen next. We expect children to bring their reading books and reading records into class every morning, so we can see how often they read. It also provides an opportunity for us to reply to any notes you may have written.
