### Maths

### Phonics

The children have been working extremely hard in their phonics over the last term and we have been very proud of how enthusiastic they have been in their learning.

## Our foundation subjects

In Science, we have been revisiting seasonal changes and weather in the UK compared to weather worldwide, and this will be linked to the children's forest school visits. We will be looking to take the children out for a walk around our local area as part of our Geography unit, where they will identify human and physical features.

The children enjoyed our 'Superhero' themed music lessons and in Art the children will be using flora and fauna to inspire their artwork through drawing and collage making of the plants and insects around them.

DT at the end of term will be a whole day planning and making windmills and in RE we will continue our unit of work learning about Judaism.

We will be looking at the unit 'Changing Me' this term which will involve teaching the children the names of body parts.
